

Just like a weave, crotchet has to do with first braiding your natural hair into loose cornrows. This cornrow pattern makes up the foundation for your crochet braids. Next, hair extensions are threaded through and maintained with a crochet pin and then plaited into your preferred braided style.



#### 3. Cornrow Braids

Cornrow Braids never just go out of style. Each hair is formed into neat rows, which is where it gets its name from. Cornrows have multiple style ideas They can be thick, or mixed with other braid styles. While they require little maintenance, they also last for several weeks leaving a light feeling on your neck.



#### 4. Knotless Braids

This braid style is very protective, has a unique outlook and also helps your natural hair growth. Unlike other braided styles, they do not put much pressure on your scalp. With the way your braids and natural hair are put together, it prevents your hair from breakage. If you would consider this style, ensure not to leave them for more than six weeks so as to prevent breakage of your natural hair. You can also add more beauty to your braids by adding a touch of waves or curls at the end.



#### 5. Twist Braids

Whether small, medium or jumbo, these twists go well! The most common twist braids are derived from Senegal. This is because of their appearance; a rope-like thick braid. You can rock this style with different looks, according to your taste. Bright colors of hair extensions, length, packing it in different styles and using different accessories. They are the longest lasting braids, as you can carry them for up to four months. You can twist your hair in a lot of forms, using any hair extension of your choice. Don't let summer go without rocking a braid style of your choice.
